Terms of Reference (ToR)

Project background

The "**PRIDE for LGBTI in Albania and Kosovo (PRIDE**++) – Promoting Rights, Inclusiveness, Dignity, and Equality for LGBT in Albania and Kosovo", project aims to support Albanian and Kosovar partners in in supporting and better protecting the LGBTIQ+ community, advocating against discrimination, and urging their governments to amend and implement existing legislation. This project is co-funded by the Agence Française de Développement and The European Union.

Background of Aleanca Kunder Diskriminimit LGBT

Aleanca LGBT is an Albanian non-governmental organization that envisions a free from discrimination, open and equal Albanian society that embraces diversity and is inclusive of people of all sexual orientations, and gender identities. The Mission is to support, empower and increase the visibility of the LGBTI communities in Albania. To enhance and protect the human rights of LBTI women and LBTI sex workers. To strengthen advocacy tools and capacities to ensure meaningful participation on policy level and development and implementation of programs that addresses LBTI women and LBTI sex worker's issues. To document the human rights abuses that serve as barrier to full realization of LGBTI and LBTI sex workers rights to access to services.

Background of STREHA Center

Streha Center provides services to the LGBTIQ+ community in Albania and the region in cases of emergencies, including shelter and other psycho-social services for the empowerment of LGBTI+ individuals. Streha aims to empower and assist LGBTIQ+ individuals, mainly youth, through its multidisciplinary and residential services, capacity-building of service providers, public awareness, and advocacy, to overcome barriers and difficulties faced by the LGBTI+ community in families and society. The primary focus of Streha is the empowerment and reintegration into society of at-risk youth within the LGBTI+ community (aged 18 to 29). The service is provided in the capital city of Albania, Tirana. However, it is not limited to the country and often offers services to Albanian youth from neighboring countries, such as Kosovo, North Macedonia, and Montenegro.





Service requested:

Alliance against Discrimination of LGBT and Streha Center are looking for an IT Expert – or a team of experts - , who will be responsible for developing two comprehensive online platforms that will serve as a database to track and monitor services and activities of each above mentioned organization provided to beneficiaries, generate data to report on activities and services provided to beneficiaries, manage activities, and provide detailed descriptions. This platform will be an essential tool to restructure Streha's and Aleanca's operations and enhance data management efficiency, as well as monitoring of services provided.

Responsibilities of the Expert

The IT professional will be responsible for the following tasks:

- Platform Development:
 - Design and develop a robust database to store beneficiary information.
 - Create modules for data generation, activity management, and description details.
 - Ensure the platform is user-friendly, secure, and scalable.
- Requirements Gathering:
 - Work closely with staff to understand their needs and requirements.
 - o Document functional and technical requirements.
- Implementation:
 - Develop and deploy the platform within the agreed timeline.
 - Ensure seamless integration with existing systems (if any).
- Testing and Quality Assurance:
 - Conduct thorough testing to identify and fix bugs.
 - Ensure the platform meets all specified requirements.
- Training and Support:
 - Provide training to staff on how to use the platform.
 - Offer ongoing support and maintenance post-deployment.

Deliverables

The IT professional is expected to deliver the following:

- Two fully functional platforms that meets the specified requirements.
- Documentation of the platform's architecture, design, and user manuals.
- Training sessions for Aleanca's and Streha's staff for the usage of the platform.
- Regular assistance in the usage of the platform.
